Each meeting we have a series of short presentations with ideas that you can use in your shop. If you have something you'd like to share, contact the meeting's group chair. Topics can include: Safety, Sharpening, New (orhandy) tools or materials, Jigs and Fixtures, Finishing or general Shop Tips.

Jim Schaeffer Toy Drive

George Murphy has been distributing toy parts and coordinating our Cincinnati Woodworking Club support of the Christian Appalachian Project, a charity centered in Mt. Vernon, Ky. As most of you know, toys and other items made or donated are to be brought to our November 12th meeting and will be immediately delivered.

Toy Collection is before the start of this Meeting – Bring the toys for the Jim Schaeffer Christian Appalachian Project (CAP) and filled out tracking form at the end of this newsletter directly to the trailer or area of the parking lot left of the entrance leading down to our meeting room. Pre-box and seal except for one of each type for show & tell and photographing. On the outsides of boxes, just mark what's inside. On the tracking form indicate how many there are of each item donated, who contributed, and their addresses. (Just use a sheet of paper if you don't have a printer.) Give the completed tracking form to George Murphy who will affix matching numbers to the form and show & tell items. Then take your numbered unboxed toy(s) to the table in the meeting room. After show and tell presentation, all those items will be boxed together. If you need boxes, call George 513-729-0092.

Safety Requirements for Toys

- NO FINISH OF ANY KIND, even though you believe it is "safe". This includes printed decals and felt pen decoration.
- NO VINYL PARTS
- SMALL PARTS
 - Check for small parts whether attached, removable or as a separate piece using the small parts test cylinder. Area group leaders have test cylinders available or bring parts to the meeting.
 - If attached, small parts must be firmly secured to resist 15 lb pulling force. We recommend using two different securing methods on small parts, for example glue plus nail or screw. Pull testing is available at the meeting.
- CORDS, ROPE, & STRING
 - Pull cords for pull toys can be of any length but they cannot have any knots, ball or handle on the pull end. Pull end of cord cannot exceed the diameter of the cord itself.
 - Cords, rope or string other than pull cords must be less than 12 inches in length.
