Recalls:

I have discovered a clearing house for recalls on all types of products. If you haven't heard of it, its **Www.cpsc.gov**. It's the Consumer Product Safety Commission. They have recalls on everything from baby bottles to worm probes. Don't ask. The following are a few you might find of interest.

Skil Warrior Drill Battery Chargers:

The transformer inside the charger can overheat. The charger housing can melt and deform, possibly igniting flammable materials near or on the charger. These chargers were sold with or as accessories for Skil Warrior drills. The drills are black with red trim. The voltage sizes are 9.6, 12, 14.4 and 18 volts. Makita Recall To Repair Circular Saws:

This is for 7 1/4 inch circular saws with a model number of 5740NB. The lower blade guard of the saw can become jammed, which can result in the consumer coming in contact with the blade and suffering serious injury. The saw should be returned to a Makita factory service center for a free repair. Contact Makita USA at (800)462-5482 between 8 AM and 4:30 PM Monday through Friday.

Any 5740NB circular saw with an "N" preceding the serial number on the nameplate and a blue dot on the shipping carton are not involved in this recall.

Recalls:

Makita Recall To Repair Electric Sanders

The recalled models include the BO5000 and BO5001. The pads on the sanders can break apart during use and strike the operator, posing an injury hazard to consumers.

Any BO5000 or BO5001 sanders with the letters "PUR" on the pad are not involved in this recall. Contact Makita USA at (800)462-5482 between 8 AM and 4:30 PM Monday through Friday

Sears Recall Routers

The on-off switch on the routers could stick in the "on" position, posing a risk of serious lacerations to the operator and bystanders.

This recall involves Craftsman® routers, model number 315.17510 with date codes of A0304 or lower. The model numbers and date codes are printed on a black data label located on the electric motor's housing. The routers have an aluminum base with black handles and a black motor. All affected routers were packaged with a cloth carry bag under the stock number 17518. Routers sold without the bag are not involved in the recall.

Sears sold these routers nationwide from November 2002 through January 2003 for about \$60. Consumers should stop using these routers immediately and return them to their nearest Sears store for a product exchange. Black & Decker Recalls Table Saws

Black & Decker (U.S.) Inc., of Towson, Md., is voluntarily recalling about 6,100 table saws. The motor housing on the saw may crack, posing a risk of electric shock to consumers.

Black & Decker has not received any reports of injuries. This recall to repair is being conducted to prevent the occurrence of injuries.

The recall involves 10-inch table saws, made in Taiwan, with the model number BT2500 and dates codes 200128-CT through 200148-CT. The model number and date codes are located on a name plate on the front panel above the power switch. The saw is grey with an orange front panel. The name "Black & Decker" is located on the lower right hand portion of the front panel.

Home centers and hardware stores nationwide sold the table saws from August 2001 through April 2002 for about \$400.

Consumers should stop using these table saws immediately, unplug them, and call Black & Decker at (866) 357-0324 between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. ET Monday through Friday to arrange for a free repair. For more information, consumers can log on to the company's website at www.blackanddecker.com.
