Fred Weissborn and Founders' Awards

Each May we hold two competitions, the Founders' Award and the Fred Weissborn Craftsmanship Award. **Please sign up at the March meeting or contact Dusty Eling by April 10 (513-563-8237) if you plan to enter either competition.** If we don't get a quorum for a category, that category will be deferred until next year.

Bring your favorite project (or a picture of the project) to the May meeting to participate in The Founders' Award competition. You can give a 3-5 minute presentation discussing your project. Members present at the meeting will vote to determine the top three projects. This competition is open to all members and any type of project. We need at least 6 members to sign up in advance in order to hold the competition. This judging will be held at the May meeting.

Since we did not have a Weissborn Award in May 2016 due to lack of a sufficient number of entries, any project made since May 2015 will be eligible this year. Additional entries in both categories are needed to hold the competition in each category at the May, 2017 meeting.

The Fred Weissborn Craftsmanship competition is for more advanced projects. These projects are judged by craftsmen inside and outside the club. We need at least 4 members to sign up in order to hold this competition. This judging is held at the location of the wood project or at a designated location prior to the May meeting. The winner will be announced at the May meeting. A slide show including all entries will also be presented.
